MAMA Project has been working very closely with TWIC (Transformation of the World in Christ) since Rev. Paul reached out to us for help and we have been in constant contact. He visited MAMA Kenya in Nairobi where he met Evelina Ndilu from Nairobi and Julia Christensen from MAMA Project, USA. Since then, we have had regular strategy meetings on Zoom except Rev. Paul and Dr. Biar missed our last meeting because it rained (That is very good news!) and they got stuck in the mud on the road back from the IDP camp (Bad news...).

We have sent the first funds for the feeding program, which is underway! We have also ordered lifesaving medications to treat the diseases that are rampant in the camp, like malaria and pneumonia.
